Letter from a recipient of a NA'AMAT USA Academic Scholarship in Israel

First of all, I want to thank the Na'amat organization and you, dear donors, for the privilege given to me of receiving your scholarship.

I'd like to share with you briefly the story of my life and how significant it is for me to receive this scholarship.

I, Tami, am a third – year student in software engineering.

I am the daughter of a drug addict who has been addicted to hard drugs for as long as I can remember.

My family is of very low socio-economic status, which means that I have always shared household expenses, worked hard to sustain myself and aid my family, which more than once has fallen into heavy debts.

In addition, several years ago I went through a very unpleasant divorce, which contributed more than slightly to the difficulties of daily life.

I enrolled in studies knowing that this step is unlikely to be a simple one at all for me, but I did with total faith that if you will it, it is indeed no dream. **אם תרצו אין זו אגדה!**
